



All units within the Office of Student Engagement have created assessment goals specifically tailored to each operation. Each goal (with one exception) has at least one measurable outcome associated with it. These goals and outcomes are intended to have three year lifespans, so have key performance indicators with key deadlines to guide operational adjustments, if warranted. Lastly, an assessment method is attached to each outcome.

Additionally, all goals are aligned to both a Marian University strategic plan theme and at least one institutional student learning goal.

Not all outcomes have fully developed assessment plans at the time of this report. Additionally, including the outcomes, initiatives, key performance indicators and timetables, and metrics would make for an unwieldy table.
